
SUPPLIES NEEDED

- 1 Transparency Marker

DIRECTIONS

- Print pages 2-3 two-sided on cardstock paper. Then print pages 54-55 twosided on cardstock paper. (Be sure to chose "flip on short edge" when printing)
- Print pages 4-53 two-sided on regular printer paper.
- Laminate all the pages and then bind the pages together (Staples or Office Depot can do this for a small fee) along the left hand side.
- Use a transparency marker to fill in the blanks. Erase with a baby wipe or glass cleaner.

A Note for Parents:

Deuteronomy 6:5-9 says:

"You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up. You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates."

As parents, we are instructed to teach our children the commandments of God. This book is one way to help your children learn some of God's Word so that... "when he is old he will not depart from it." (Proverbs 22:6)

There are two pages of each verse. On the left side, use the pictures to help your younger (non-reading) children to memorize the verses. Your older (reading) children can use the pages on the right to fill-inthe-blanks using transparency markers on each verse. (Markers can be cleaned off the with a baby wipe or with a paper towel and glass cleaner.)
