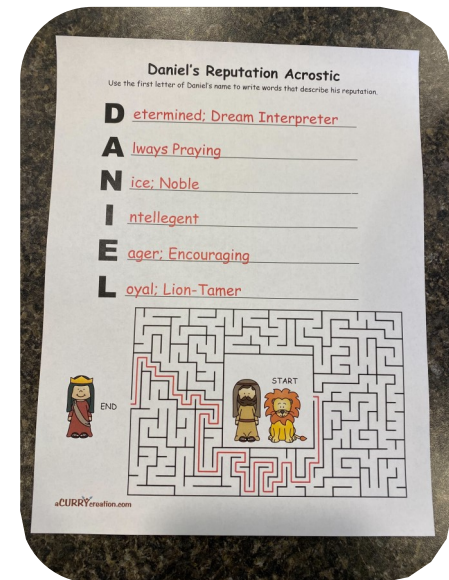
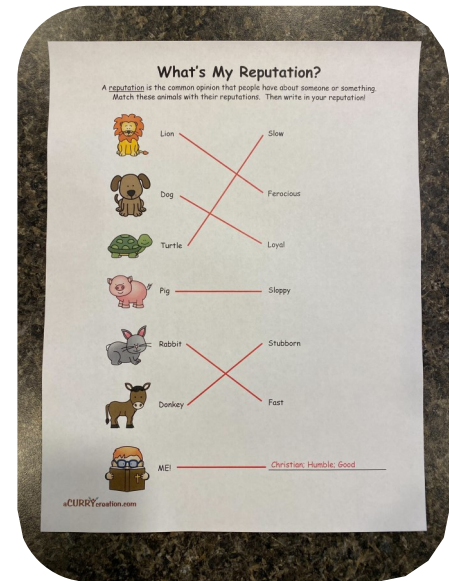
SUPPLIES NEEDED

DIRECTIONS

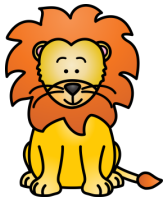
- Print pages 2-3 two-sided for each child. Page 4-5 are the Answer Keys.

Match these animals with their reputations. Then write in your reputation!



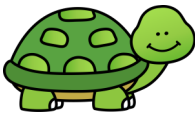

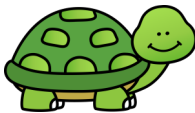
