



Rocket to the Moon

SUPPLIES NEEDED

You will need the following:

6-7 Sheets of Cardstock (8.5" x 11")

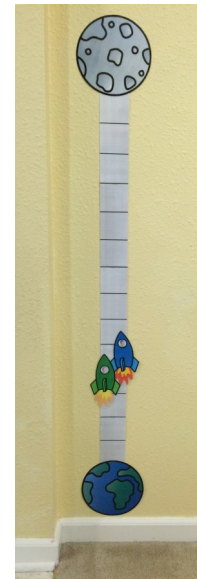

6-7 3 mil Laminating Film

DIRECTIONS

- Print pages 2-6 one-sided on cardstock. Print enough rockets on pages 7-8 for each child.
- If desired, cut out the circle window on the rockets and tape your child's picture on the back so that his/her head shows through the window. Or write your child's name on the rocket.
- Laminate and cut out all the pictures.
- Use clear packaging tape to tape the gray lines together then staple to the wall.
- Use masking tape or putty to affix the children's rockets.



TIPS

- This reward system can be used for different things. If they do all their chores without me reminding them, they move up a notch. If they get a 100% on a test, they can move up a notch, etc.
- You can do as many or as few days/lines as you want. Mine is set-up for 14 days.
- When your child makes it to the moon they should be rewarded with something. My boys get a dollar when they reach the moon.
