

- 1 Sheet of Printer Paper (8.5" x 11")




Haggai Booklet

DIRECTIONS

- Print the booklet (pages 2-3) front and back on cardstock paper.
 Fold the booklet in half lengthwise first and then in half again to make a booklet. "Haggai" should be on the front.
- Print the pictures (page 4) on regular paper. Cut out the pictures before class and put them in a Ziploc snack bag for each student.
- After reading the Haggai story, have students glue the pictures to your booklet as you review what each message was about.
- Note: The "TO" envelopes should be glued in the top right

corners for each message so there is space underneath for the pictures summarizing what the message was about.


