



## Official's Son Story Cube

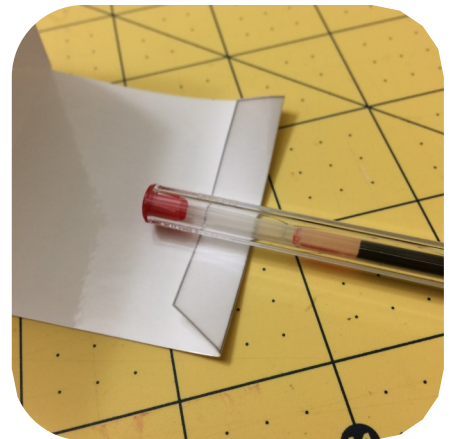
### SUPPLIES NEEDED

For each child you will need the following:

- 1 Sheets of [Cardstock](#) (8.5" x 11")
- 1 3 mil Laminating [Film](#)
- 4 Clear [Velcro](#) Dots
- 1 Clear Mini [Velcro](#) Dot

### DIRECTIONS

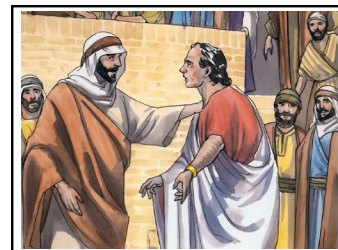
- Print page 2 on cardstock paper and then laminate it.
- Cut out the four pictures and set them aside. Cut out the cube on the outer lines.
- Fold on the inner lines to make a box (use the edge of a pen or pencil to help crease the laminated folds). Use clear tape to tape the outside edges together and the inside tabs together (do not tape Tab A).
- Put one clear mini velcro dot on Tab A to keep the box shut.
- Put clear velcro dots on the backs of the four pictures to attach them to the side of the box in the correct order. Then store the pictures inside the cube.
- During class, use these [slides](#) to retell the story.
- Give each child a story cube with their pictures inside. Ask them to try and put the pictures in the correct order on the outside of their cube.
- Then give students the sick boy picture to put inside their "Jesus the Great Physician" booklet in their Miracles of Jesus Lapbook.

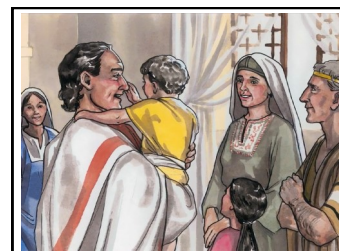
