- 12 3 mil Laminating Film




- Print pages 2-25 two-sided on regular printer paper. Laminate each page.

- After the story, give the students the John the Baptist Worksheet to answer the questions.









When Herod was king of Judea, there was a Jewish priest named Zechariah and his wife, Elizabeth. They had been unable to have children and were both very old.








While Zechariah was in the sanctuary, an angel of the Lord appeared to him, standing by the incense altar. Zechariah was overwhelmed with fear.
















5 'How can I be sure this will happen?' asked Zechariah. 'I'm an old man, and my wife is also old.'








John grew up and became strong. He lived in the wilderness. His clothing was made of camel hair and he had a leather belt. He ate locust and wild honey.
