

DIRECTIONS

- Print page 2 or 3 on regular printer paper. (Page 2 already has the country divided into 6.
 Page 3 allows you to divide the country into however many students you have.)
- Print pages 4 and 5 on cardstock and laminate page 5.
- Cut out the tribal lands on page 5. It works best if you do not leave any of the black lines.
 Use an Exacto knife to cut out the land of Simeon.
- Use clear Velcro dots to attach the tribal lands in their appropriate places on page 4. It should work like a puzzle. (Use half a Velcro dot for the land of Ephraim.)
- During class, tell the story from Numbers 26 and Joshua 13-19 about taking a census and
 dividing the Promised Land among the Israelites. Use page 2 or 3 to explain how to take a
 census. Write a child's name down and ask them to count how many are in his/her
 immediate family (Dad, Mom, brother, sister). Then color the divided America according to
 your class census.
- Then give each child a page 4 with the land puzzle pieces in a Ziploc bag and have them complete the picture by adding the land pieces.
