

OT Board: Who Am I? (Gen. - 2 Sam.)

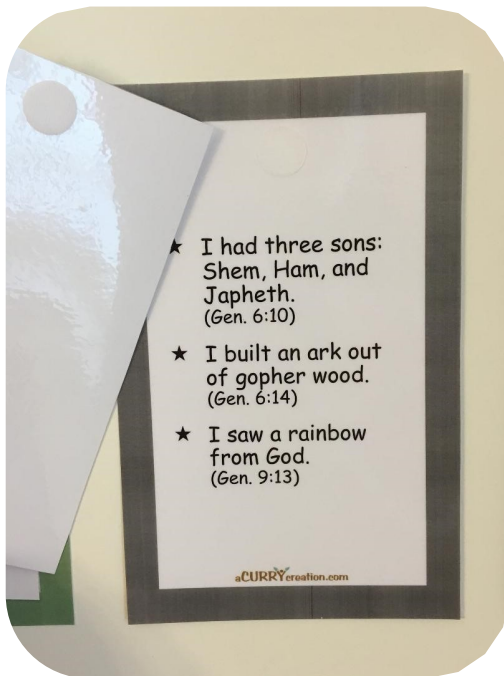
SUPPLIES NEEDED

You will need the following:

- 26 Sheets of [Cardstock](#) (8.5" x 11")
- 26 Clear [Velcro](#) Dots
- 26 3 mil [Laminating](#) Film

DIRECTIONS

- Print pages 2-27 one-sided on cardstock and then laminate all pages.
- Cut out all the rectangles on the dotted lines or along the colored borders. Staple the colored clue cards to your bulletin board.
- Use one clear Velcro dots above the clues to attach the correct name cards to the correct clues cards.
- During class, read the clues to the students and have the children take turns picking which person matches the clues on the board.
- Use as many or as few as you need during your quarter. If there is a person not included that you would like, send me a message and I will try to add him/her.
